






### **EDF Working Group**

- Expert Study Sessions will be scheduled on the first Wednesday of the month from 3:30 to 5 pm




### **EDF Working Group Role**

- Enhance participants' existing public finance expertise through expert sessions and information sharing among the group members.
- Equip the group with tools to become more effective in pursuing state and federal funds, philanthropy, and other sources of revenue to help make projects viable.



### **EDF Working Group Goals**

- Establish body of knowledge to be used in evaluation of projects for the California Jobs First Funding.
- Review projects for initial financing feasibility ranking and make recommendations to RISE Sector Tables and the Collaborative.
