



# Del Norte County: Percent of Age Group Enrolled in School, 2005-2009



Total K-8 — Total 9-12 — Total K-12






#### Highest Level of Educational Attainment, 2005-2009



# Del Norte County: Median Annual Income by Highest Level of Educational Attainment. 2005-2009



# Del Norte County: Percent of Children Not Attending Preschool, Nursery School or Head Start at Least 10 Hours per Week






### Del Norte County: Students Enrolled in Free/Reduced Price Meals


# Del Norte County: Percent of Students Eligible for Free/Reduced Price Lunch, but Not Participating in the Program






# Del Norte County: Percent of Students Grades 2-11 with Proficient or Advanced Scores on the English-Language Arts Section of the STAR Test


### Del Norte County: Percent of 10<sup>th</sup> Grade Students Passing the English-Language Arts Section of the California High School Exit Exam


# Del Norte County: Percent of 10<sup>th</sup> Grade Students Passing the English-Language Arts Section of the California High School Exit Exam


#### **Del Norte County: Average High School Graduation Rates**






### **Del Norte County: High School 4-Year Drop Out Rate**


### Del Norte County: High School 4-Year Drop Out Rate by Race/Ethnicity






### Del Norte County: Percent of High School Graduates with UC/CSU Required Courses




# Del Norte County: Percent of High School Graduates with UC/CSU Required Courses by Race/Ethnicity



# Del Norte County: Percent of 10<sup>th</sup> Grade Students Passing the Math Section of the California High School Exit Exam






# Del Norte County: Percent of Students Grades 2-11 with Proficient or Advanced Scores on the Science Section of the STAR Test

# Del Norte County: Percent of 10<sup>th</sup> Grade Students Passing the Math Section of the California High School Exit Exam






