



FACT SHEET: REDWOOD REGION RISE CALIFORNIA JOBS FIRST

What is California Jobs First?

California Jobs First (formerly “CERF”) is a state-wide program designed to foster **shared, sustainable prosperity** across the state. CA Jobs First will distribute \$600 million across California to help communities build ten year plans that seek to boost local and regional economies, and uplift the people that don’t often participate in or benefit from economic development processes.

And what is Redwood Region RISE?

Redwood Region RISE (Resilient Inclusive Sustainable Economy) is the name of our region’s initiative, which includes Tribal Lands, Del Norte, Humboldt, Lake, and Mendocino Counties. Our Collaborative is a broad, diverse coalition of close to a thousand members representing organizations and communities. Together, we will develop equitable strategies and recommend investments that aim to **communities**, strengthen economic resilience and diversification, and environmental sustainability.



How is the CA Jobs First initiative structured?

- 1. Planning Phase:** Each region receives ~\$5M to create an inclusive and accountable regional planning process that results in a ten year vision and recommended series of investments: A Regional Economic Roadmap.
- 2. Catalyst Program:** The Catalyst Program allocates up to \$14 million for each of the 13 regions to bridge the gap between the Planning Phase and the Implementation Phase.
- 3. Implementation Phase:** The State provides ~\$500M in rolling, semi-competitive grants to fund projects put forward by the region’s Collaboratives. Criteria such as demonstrated community support, alignment with climate goals, demonstration of labor standards, and high-quality jobs with clear employment pathways for underserved and incumbent workers will be evaluated.

Meet the RRRISE Convener Team

The Arcata Economic Development Corporation (AEDC) is our Fiscal Agent, the California Center for Rural Policy (CCRP) our Regional Convener, and our Outreach Team is led by North Coast Opportunities (NCO), and True North Organizing Network (TNON).

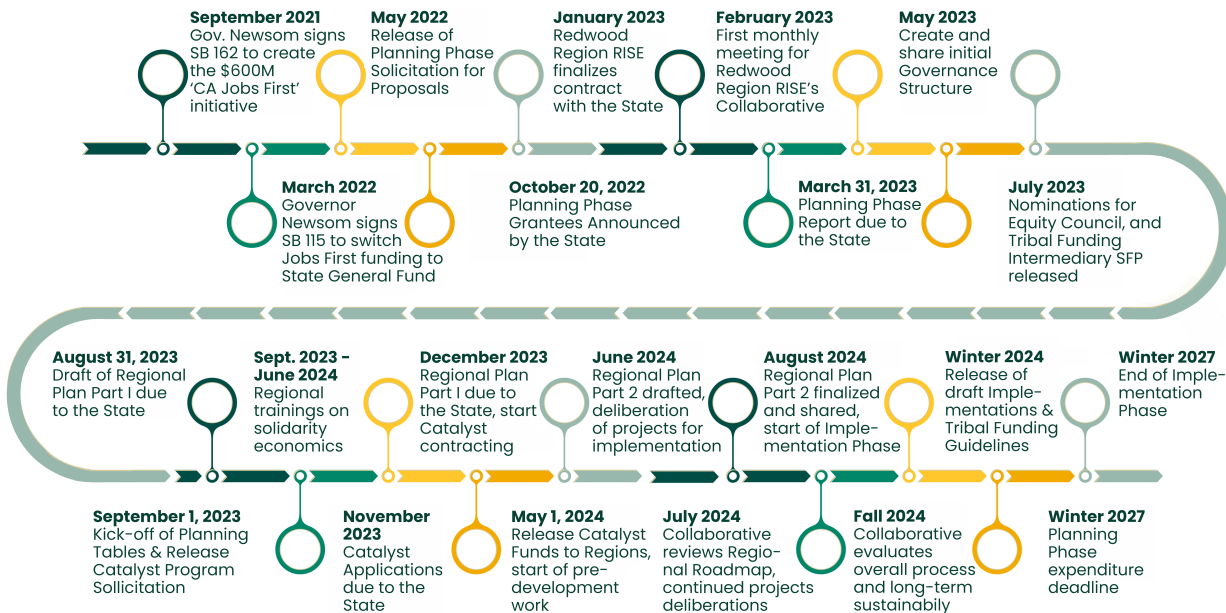
What are RRRISE’s goals?
