


### Our Guiding Light

### Community Endowment

#### Shaping the future of our region

- Financial stability: Providing stability and reducing reliance on short-term fundraising efforts
- Perpetuity: The principal is preserved, and the earnings are used for grants and operational expenses
- Flexibility and Responsiveness: Flexibility to respond to emerging needs and opportunities
- Encouraging philanthropy: Encourage and engage donors who wish to make an impact
- Economic impact: Contribute to the local economy through supporting job creation and economic development initiatives



## Enriching the Local Safety Net

Responsive relief and coordinated disaster preparedness activities for Mendocino County.


#### **Response and Recovery:**

- \$3.8 M in COVID-19 relief
  - \$231,500 in business assistance
  - \$796,000 in individual assistance
- \$7.5M raised and leveraged for five wildfires
- Distributed \$105,000, leveraging an additional \$70,000 of county funds for the 2023 storm response

#### **Preparedness and Resiliency**

- Regional COADs and VOADs
- \$100,000 in BIPOC resiliency mini-grants





## Supporting an Equitable Economy

Leveraging resources, networks, and local knowledge to drive positive change.

- Funding local initiatives: Grants to nonprofit and social enterprises help stimulate innovation and support sustainability.
- Capacity Building: Technical assistance to help build local capacity and enhance the ability of nonprofits to grow
- Convening and collaborating: Neutral conveners bring together diverse stakeholders to address community needs
- Investing in community assets: Investment in community assets improves quality of life and creates a more fertile economic environment
- Keep money in Mendocino County to benefit Mendocino County.
